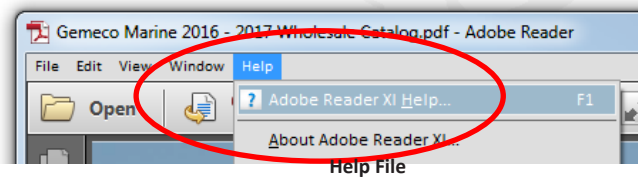


# How to locate any page or part listed in our catalog using Adobe Acrobat Reader

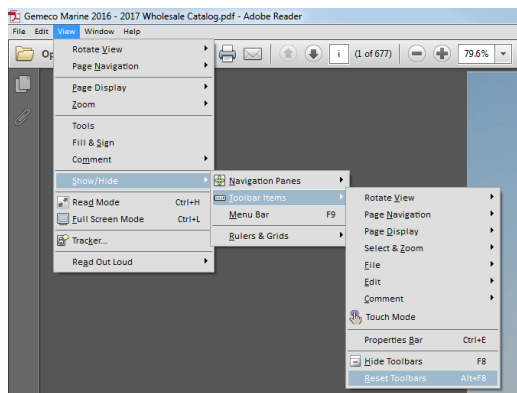
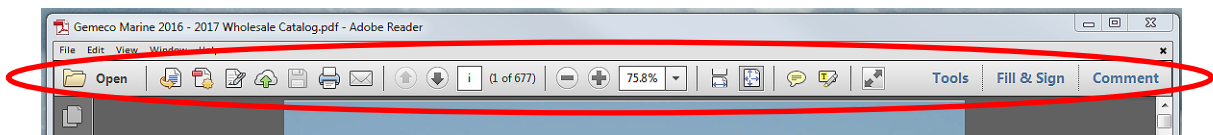
All the tips given here may be found in the Acrobat Reader Help file. We recommend you download the latest version of Adobe Acrobat Reader to view our catalog.

## How to View pages and Navigate to other locations

There are several navigation tools in Acrobat Reader, found in the **Page Navigation Toolbar** at the top of the screen, that you will find useful. The Page Navigation toolbar opens by default.

The default toolbar contains frequently used tools: the **Show Next Page** , **Show Previous Page** , and **Page Number**.

### Page Navigation Toolbar

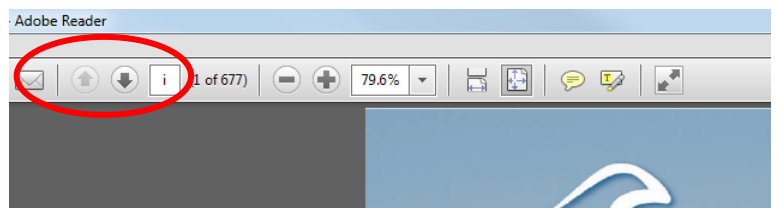

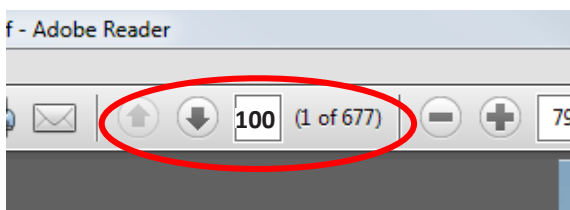
If you do not see these items, choose **View > Show/Hide > Toolbar Items > Reset Toolbars**.

## Next and Previous Page

The **Next Page** (up arrow) and **Previous Page** (down arrow) buttons appear in the Page Navigation toolbar. Click the arrow to move up or down one page.

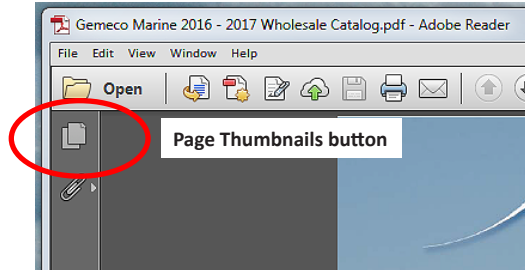


## Jump to a specific page



The text box next to them is also interactive, so you can type a page number and press the keyboard *Enter* key to go directly to that page.

## Use page thumbnails to jump to specific pages

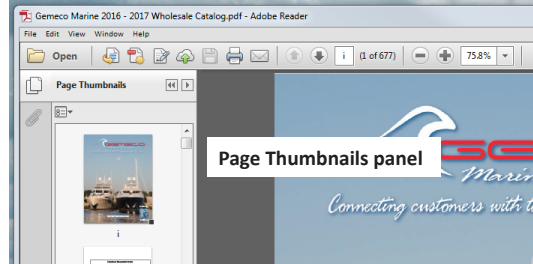


Page thumbnails provide miniature previews of document pages.

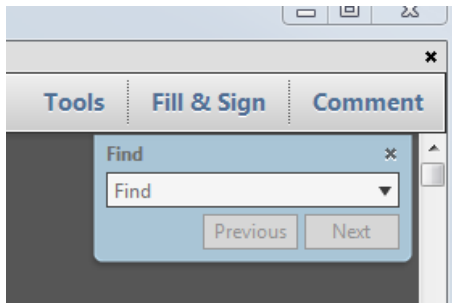
You can use thumbnails in the Page Thumbnails panel to change the display of pages and to go to other pages.

Click the Page Thumbnails button and Page Thumbnails panel is displayed.

To jump to another page, click its thumbnail.



## Find a manufacturer or part number with the Find Toolbar



Display the Find toolbar

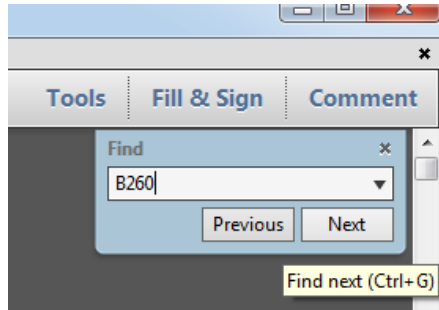
Open it by choosing **Edit > Find** (keyboard *Ctrl/Command+F*).

Type the text you want to search for in the text box on the Find toolbar, for example a manufacturer name, like *Actisense* or a part number, *B260*.

Click **Next**.

Acrobat jumps to the first instance of the search term, which appears highlighted.

Click **Next** again to go to the next instance of the search term. Or, click **Previous** to go back to the previous instance of the search term.
